



2020 Exam Results Guidance

I have no doubt that you have many questions regarding this year's exam results, hopefully you will find some of the answers below.

Results day – **Year 13 A level and BTEC – 13th August collecting from 9 am to 11.15 am**
Year 12 AS level and BTEC – 13th August collecting from 12 pm to 1 pm
Year 11 GCSE and BTEC – 20th August collecting from 9 am to 11.30 am

We are planning a socially distanced results day to give you the opportunity to collect your results in person. Obviously, there will be a few changes.

1. Timed slots – you have been allocated a time slot to collect your results from the Main Hall. **Your time slot will be sent via email/MyEd shortly. If you haven't received it by the 7th August please email the Exams Officer at pcolledge@hajc.leics.sch.uk.**
2. We ask that you do not congregate outside the hall before or after you have collected your results.
3. We ask that only you collect your results, your parents/carers are welcome to wait in the carpark but we request that they do not come into the hall.
4. We request that you maintain the 2 meter distance at all times **and use hand sanitiser.**
5. A one-way system will operate in the hall.
6. **We request that if you feel unwell please do not collect your results.**

If you do not wish to collect your results then they will be posted to the address we have on record for you.

There will be an opportunity to discuss your results with teaching staff on results day and the Friday. We can tell you your centre assessed grade but not your ranking due to GDPR.

Further Information

Appeals

If you are unhappy with your results there are three options to appeal them.

1. An input error has occurred when sending the results to the awarding body.
2. The awarding body have used the wrong data calculate the final grade.
3. Bias or discrimination on the part of the teacher when assessing the student's abilities.

For options 1 and 2 a form will be available from the Exams Office but currently we have no details from the awarding bodies as to deadline, dates or cost. Once these are released they will be displayed in the hall and on our website.

For option 3 substantive written evidence must be presented to the interim head of the school in the first instance. This evidence will be reviewed by the senior leadership team and if confirmation that bias or discrimination has taken place the matter will be forwarded to the awarding body. The student will receive a letter confirming the decision either way.

Autumn exams

You may have heard that the awarding bodies are running a full season of A level, AS level and GCSE exams in the autumn. The A/AS exams will be between the 5th and 23rd October with an **entry deadline of the 1st September**. GCSE exams are between the 2nd and 23rd November with an **entry deadline of the 14th September**.

Alternatively, you may wish to take your exams in summer 2021 in which case please contact the Exams Officer in December.
